This morning my daughter sent me an email describing a strategy that one young mother devised for teaching her children to be responsible. The letter went something like this:

Congratulations! You've been grounded!!! To get un-grounded, you must earn 500 points

- Write a nice letter to someone in the family = 10 points
- Prepare and cook dinner = 50 points
- One load of laundry (wash, dry, fold, put away) = 100 points
- Clean and organize a kitchen cupboard = 50 points per cupboard
- Empty dishwasher = 25 points
- Load dishwasher = 40 points

The approach, brilliant in its simplicity, ties misbehavior with consequences and provides benefits to boot! I got such a kick out of this because I devised a similar system when my children were young, except that I chose positive reinforcement instead of a punitive point system. 15 points and my children earned an ice cream.

- Make your bed = 1 point
- Take out the trash = 1 point
- Read for 30 minutes = 2 points

And my personal favorite:

 Swim around the dock at night = 5 points (you have never seen two kids move so fast in all of your life)!
